The academic year of 2023-24 has been characterized by something of a bounce-back. It began with a recovering local economy - after harsh COVID-19 policies - and ended with a property development boom.

Turbo-charged by a large increase in foreign national residencies. Estimates claim between 30,000 - 300,000 foreign residents currently live in Bali (although official figures are not published). Many of Bali's current foreign residents arrived shortly after the outbreak of the war in Ukraine, which enters its second year with no clear end in sight.

Also, tourism to the Island is almost back to pre-COVID numbers, reaching 5.2 million in 2023. With a total resident population of 4.4 million.

This has all led to an expansion of the resort satellites up the coastline, fueled by property specualtion. Bringing supermarkets, villa complexes, luxury hotels, food outlets, roads, clinics, schools. and even whole Russian financed 'cities'.

Costs and expenses have all surged. Directly affecting our community (both positively and negatively), as we seek to find the space to expand our facilities and control costs. However, we feel that we are in a good position to continue providing value for money. Our academy continues to thrive (due in part to our selective admission policies), with independently verifiable academic learning performance data, showing an average increase of 1.5 grades per 12 months, for all of our students as a whole.

We have managed to maintain our classroom ratios while improving our facilities with fully refurbished bathrooms/showers to top standards. We also improved the safety of the road with signage measures along Jalan Raya Buwit.

Last year saw our commercial kitchen upgrade, the new classroom building, and the upgrade for the PlayZone (multi-sports play-surface system). We continue to invest in world-class facilities that have positively impacted our members and visiting parents eager to join waiting lists for limited classroom spots in 2024-25.

Our long-term plan continues to be the expansion of the land area, through substantial capital investment.

Therefore we remain optimistic and excited about the possibilities that lie ahead by the grace of our Balinese hosts, god, and hard work.
